

Reduce your 2019 taxes & help the Birkie!

The IRA Charitable Rollover allows individuals 70 ½ or older to make direct transfers from their IRAs to the Foundation for the Endowment of the American Birkebeiner. Each transfer has a maximum of \$100,000 (\$200,000 per couple) in any one year. Donors with retirement assets in 401k or 403b can roll those funds into an IRA and then direct a transfer of the funds from the IRA to the Birkebeiner Endowment.

Save on your taxes! Because the donor's transfer occurs directly from your IRA to the Birkie, donors don't have to count the transfers as taxable income for federal tax purposes. IRA charitable rollover transfers can count as a donor's required minimum distribution (RMD) for the year.

How do you do it? You must first contact your IRA Administrator to initiate the transfer to the Foundation for the American Birkebeiner Endowment. We encourage you to notify us if you are making an IRA charitable rollover.
