

GETTING THERE

All races will start and finish in the Celebration Zone, off of Main Street and 3rd Street in Hayward, WI.

Parking is available in the open lot across from Bib Pick-up, located at 5th Street and Wisconsin Ave. Parking will also be available along the side streets in Downtown Hayward. There will NOT be a shuttle bus service.

Please enter the D entrance at the Intermediate School. At bib pick-up, participants will receive their bib! The first 900 participants will receive a ski hat. Jr. gear bags that were purchased during registration will also be ready for pick up!

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

The Barnebirkie will start and finish in the Celebration Zone off of Main Street in downtown Hayward!

- Purple Wave: Purple wave runners will complete an out-and-back on Main Street, turning around at the intersection of Main Street and Nyman Avenue.
- Red Wave: Red wave runners will run up Main Street, and turn left between the Primary and Intermediate Schools and complete two-laps, clockwise, around the playground. They will run back through the schools, turn right, and finish on Main Street in the Celebration Zone.
- Green Wave: Green wave runners will follow the same course as the red wave, but will complete onelap, clockwise around the playground.

COURSE MARKINGS

The Barnebirkie courses will be marked with orange traffic cones and white signs with red arrows! Course marshals will also be present along the course to provide directions. Be alert, follow the proper signs, and have fun!



SPECTATOR ETIQUETTE



Please note the following important information regarding the safety of the children and the integrity of the course:

- Parents or guardians are welcome to run/walk alongside of their athlete as they are completing their run. Otherwise, adults must stay off the marked course.
- Meet your little runner directly outside of the Finish Line.
 Volunteers will be on hand to reunite runners and family members. Please stay out of the direct finish line.
