Mt. Telemark Village is a premier, year-round outdoor recreation destination in Cable, Wisconsin. The property is anchored by the Mt. Telemark Village Hub - a 12,000 square foot adventure center and gateway to the outdoors. The building features the Gantz Great Room, Backroads Coffee Shop, New Moon Bike & Ski rentals and repairs, a Trek Bike retailer and the Tony Wise Museum. Many of the design elements harken back to the original Telemark Lodge property, including the Wall of Champions.
